Jérémié Heitz Goes Through Successful Surgery

Following his crash at the third stop of the Freeride World Tour in Fieberbrunn last March, Jérémié Heitz finally went through surgery. The operation was a success, and a necessary step in order to make sure that Jérémié can compete next season. It is now time to recover and to plan new projects!

The crash was an impressive one. After tomahawking down the mountain, Jérémié came out ok except for a knee injury. A few weeks later, the skier from Valais still felt pain, but this time around his ankle. An MRI would reveal that there was also some ligament damage to his ankle. He had surgery last Tuesday. "We had to make a quick decision. The surgery was a guarantee for me to be able to perform at the highest level next season. Not getting operated would have been a risk for my skiing career in the long run." Jérémié now has to be patient for a few weeks before starting physio, some downtime to think of new projects.
