In early February, the Valaisan was able to ski the fabled Materhorn alongside Sam Anthamatten and two Austrian guides. This was a wonderful experience knowing full well that he wasn't able to do this descent for his film La Liste. Jérémie Heitz can't hide his enthusiasm with regards to current conditions in the mountains. "The snow pack at the moment is quite good and allows us to access exceptionally steep terrain for this period in the high mountains."

Jérémie is also using this season as best he can to benefit his sponsors. With his new glove sponsor Reusch, he was able to help develop a new glove. This sort of project is very satisfying with Jérémie and is very in tune with how he likes to do things. The past few weeks, he also went to Munich to push his new film at ISPO, the winter industry's annual tradeshow in Europe, and featured in the Swiss show "Passe-moi les Jumelles" which will air in the spring of 2018 on the RTS.
