Jérémie Heading to Austria

The next stop of the Freeride World Tour will take place in Fieberbrunn, Austria. Organizers have decided on a weather window starting on the 6th of March until the 11th. This competition will be extremely important for Jérémie Heitz since it is the last chance to get qualified for the final stages in Alaska and Verbier, as well as for next season's Tour. Hopefully the 600 vertical meter Wildseeloder face will be wild enough for Jérémie to get his ticket. Only twelve men will qualify for the remainder of the season.

Jérémie is going into the Austrian stop in a calm and collected fashion. "This is the first time that I find myself in this position but I am confident. I'm aiming for the top of the rankings in Fieberbrunn and for the overall title, which is still possible. I know the face in Austria well, and it suits me better than those of the previous stops. More alpine, more technical and longer- it is full of aspects that play well with my style."

Since returning from Andora, the skier from les Marécotte was able to recharge his batteries at home and around his family. "Freeride is an adventure discipline. To succeed, I need to be full of energy. I was able to concentrate on my skiing and my surroundings."
